ART CENTER GUIDELINES

You must be a member of the Artists Guild to exhibit and sell in the VAC (Visual Arts Center).

The application to exhibit and sell in the VAC is a three step process:

- Complete the attached application and submit 3-5 photos of your current work. You may email digital pictures to <u>rcvartg@gmail.com</u>. Reference your application and size of the work in your email. DO NOT bring in your work until the application process is complete and accepted.
- The application is juried by the VAC Committee at which time you may be asked to bring in samples of your work for review.
- Once juried you will be contacted for an appointment to bring in your work and sign a contract with VAC for exhibiting and selling your work.

The VAC Review Committee meets at least once a quarter to review applications and welcome new artists. You will receive a confirmation once your application is received with the date of the next review.
